A By-Law to close and stop up all that portion of Bruce Street lying Northely of the Northely limit of Russell Street produced Easterly

Whereas Richard Seymour Robinson of the Village of Watford Lumber Merchant has made application to the Municipal Council of the Village of Watford asking that a By-Law be passed closing up that part of Bruce Street lying North of Russell Street

And Whereas the said Richard Seymour Robinson is the owner of all the land fronting on the said part of Bruce Street on both the East and West Sides thereof

And Whereas the said Richard Seymour Robinson has agreed with the Municipality of the Village of Watford to bear sustain and pay all the expenses and costs necessary to legally pass and put into force the herein by-law and has further also agreed at his own proper cost and expense to open grade and lay out Russell Street to and for the public use

And Whereas that portion of Bruce Street above referred to has never in fact been opened laid out or used by the public and has not been assumed by the said Village of Watford

And Whereas the Council of the Village of Waterford
has heard in person all persons whose land
might be prejudicially affected by the passing
of this By-Law and who have petitioned the
said Council to be heard

And Whereas it is expedient and desirable that
the said part of Bruce Street should be closed and
shut up.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Village
of Waterford enacts as follows

That all that portion of Bruce Street in the
Village of Waterford in the County of Norfolk
lying wholly of the northerly limit of Russell
Street produced Easterly according to the Plan
of the said Village prepared by S. Harry Jones Esq
P.L.S. and registered in the Norfolk Registry Office
as Plan No. 19. B. forthwith after the final
passing of this By-Law be closed and stopped up
and shut up as a public street or highway
for all purposes and ceased to be and be called
a part or portion of Bruce Street

day of September 1901
