
April 2024 Staff Proposal

- None of the 6 from February are in.
- 29.9 ha on Ireland Road are in (not included in February).
- 41.8 ha are being removed.
- Net LOSS of 11.9 ha from urban boundary.
- Grow Norfolk > Shrink Simcoe
- All the eggs in 1 basket
- Why this radical change.
- Ghesquiere / Silvestri combined and corrected score is the best.



Norfolk Scoring Challenge

- Submission was based on 1 comprehensive plan.
- Norfolk staff have evaluated as 2 parcels
- Scoring reduced when separated.
- Score improves significantly when considered as 1 comprehensive package.



This is the ONLY location in the NCOP where future roads are anticipated OUTSIDE of the current urban area. Norfolk County has planned this expansion for decades. Harvest Glen Subdivision was required to build infrastructure to accommodate this expansion – now that same developer wants to use it.

Norfolk County Schedule E

- Map for each urban area including Simcoe
- Shows Oak Street and Queen Street Collector Roads.
- Both Collectors to be extended to Ghesquiere & Silvestri.
- UNIQUE
 - ONLY location in the NCOP where future roads are indicated beyond the current urban boundary.
- Clearly strong vision for future expansion to Ghesquiere & Silvestri.
- Holy Trinity High School located here in anticipation of that southerly urban boundary expansion.
- Norfolk required Silvestri to incurred significant additional cost to install these services to the property line....now the same developer wants to use those services.

- Only property in NCOP specially designated for expansion.
- Must be scored as 1 proposal
- Scores very well meets all objectives
- Planned expansion of existing Harvest Glen subdivision
- Anticipated by NCOP
- A+ for servicing: water, sanitary, storm water



REQUEST

Include the entire Ghesquiere & Silvestri proposal within urban boundary.

ID: 10 and ID:11 in the staff report.

Council can add this AND the piece on Ireland Road.

It does not need to be one or the other.

Think big.
