By-Law 2017-44

Being a By-Law to Authorize the Use of Optical Scanning Vote Tabulators for the 2018 Norfolk County Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at their municipal elections;

AND WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of alternative voting methods.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County hereby authorizes the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes during the 2018 Norfolk County Municipal Election.
- 2. That the effective date of this By-Law shall be the date of passage thereof.
