Background

The purpose of this memo is to inform Council of the delegated road closure activity for the Port Dover Canada Day Parade on Tuesday July 1st, 2025.

Discussion:

As part of the annual Port Dover Canada Day Parade event, the Port Dover Lions Club organize a parade in the afternoon followed by a fireworks display and live music in the evening at Silver Lake. The annual Soap Box Derby and Boat Parade will continue in 2025. The following road closures will be in effect for the event:

Canada Day Parade

The following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic on Tuesday July 1, 2025 from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00. p.m.

- Dover Avenue from Thompson Drive to St. George Street
- Main Street from St. Andrew Street to Harbour Street
- St. George Street from Geoffery Road to Harbour Street
- Walker Street from St. George Street to St. Andrew Street
- Clinton Street from St. George Street to St. Andrew Street
- Market Street West from Drayton Street to Main Street
- Market Street East from Main Street to St. Andrew Street
- Park Street from Main Street to St. Andrew Street
- Chapman Street West from Drayton Street to St. Andrew Street

- Nelson Street East from First Avenue to St. Andrew Street
- McNab Street East from First Avenue to Main Street
- Greenock Street East from First Avenue to St. Andrew Street

Soap Box Derby

The following road shall be closed to vehicular traffic on Tuesday July 1, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Main Street from Park Street to Harbour Street

Boat Parade

The following road shall be closed to vehicular traffic on Tuesday July 1, 2025 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Harbour Street from Main Street to the westerly end of the street

Any costs associated with the additional temporary road closures on Tuesday July 1st, 2025 as identified above will be accommodated within current operating base budgets.
