Background

The purpose of this memo is to inform Council of the delegated road closure activity for the Remembrance Day Ceremonies in Waterford, Simcoe and Port Dover on Tuesday November 11th, 2025.

Discussion:

The following road closure will be in effect in **Waterford** on Tuesday, November 11th from 10:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.:

- East Church Street from Albert Lane (Waterford Arena) to Main Street
- Main Street from East Church Street to Nichol Street

The following road closure will be in effect in **Simcoe** on Tuesday, November 11th from 10:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.:

- Norfolk Street North from Bonnie Drive to Union Street
- Wilson Drive from Norfolk Street North to Bertha Street
- Alligator Lane from Kent Street North to Norfolk Street North

The following road closure will be in effect in **Port Dover** on Tuesday, November 11th from 10:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.:

- Market Street East from St. Patrick Street to Main Street
- St. Andrew Street from Market Street East to Park Street
- Park Street from St. Andrew Street to Main Street
- Main Street from Park Street to Chapman Street East

Any costs associated with the November 11th temporary road closures as identified above will be accommodated within current operating base budgets.
