



The Corporation of Norfolk County

By-Law 2025-77

Being a by-law to provide for a partial abandonment and variation in assessment of drainage works in The Corporation of Norfolk County for the McKoy Municipal Drain 2024.

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of Norfolk County has procured a report under section 84 of the *Drainage Act* for a partial abandonment of the McKoy Municipal Drain 2024; and

Whereas the report dated May 10, 2024 has been authored by Dietrich Engineering Limited and the attached report forms Schedule "A" of this by-law; and

Whereas the estimated total cost of engineering for the drainage report is \$5,085; and

Whereas \$5,085 is being assessed to the landowners in the drainage area in Norfolk County; and

Whereas the Council is of the opinion that the drainage report is desirable.

Now therefore Council of The Corporation of Norfolk County pursuant to the *Drainage Act* hereby enacts as follows:

1. Authorization

The attached report is adopted and the partial abandonment and variation in assessment of the drainage works is authorized and shall be completed as specified in the report.

2. Borrowing

The Corporation of Norfolk County may borrow on the credit of the Corporation the amount of \$5085; being the amount necessary for engineering of the drainage report.

This project will not be debentured.

3. Citation

This by-law comes into force and effect on the passing thereof and may be cited as the McKoy Municipal Drain 2024 Drain By-law.
