Recommendation(s):

That the Information Memo regarding the Long Point Beach Access Points 2026 be received as information.

Background

Council has requested that staff inform council and the public each spring on which beach access points are recommended for closure in Long Point.

Discussion:

Please be advised that for the 2026 season all access points are open.

The access points on Woodstock Avenue (63B, 97B, 137B and 165B), Beach Avenue (30B and 53B) and Sandy Lane (7B) are all open and have been deemed safe for use for the 2026 beach season.

Norfolk County staff will continue to monitor each of the access points throughout the season for changing conditions.

Portable washrooms and garbage cans will be installed as of May 24th weekend. Also, the beach access points have all been levelled for the 2026 season.

Financial Services Comments:

The Adopted 2026 Levy Operating Budget for the Parks, Recreation and Culture Department contains various allocations for portable toilets, garbage collection, etc. consistent with the service level indicated above.
