Dear Devin Upon rereading our first email to	you we noticed a couple of errors, so we are sending a revised email.
Since 1975 Snooks Drive has been closed at Old Hill Road from May 24th weekend to Labour Day weekend. This was done by approval of Council to alleviate the excessive amount of traffic during the summer months. Prior to closure the residents of Snooks Drive and Harold Street were subjected to constant traffic to get from Old Hill Road to Cedar Drive or vice versa.	
On more than one occasion residents sustained damage to property. The worst of these involved the destruction of a front porch on one property and the shifting of a building from its foundation when drivers lost control of their vehicles. In addition it became difficult if not impossible for parents to walk their children along Harold Street to the beach due to dangerous operation of vehicles.	
With co-operation of Council members who spent time with residents counting vehicles, this untenable situation was mitigated by the seasonal closure of Snooks Drive. Since neither Snooks Drive nor Harold Street are wide enough for two way summer traffic, activating the seasonal closure has worked well for over forty years.
